Growth of Student Groups Reporting

Growth of Student Groups reporting provides district and school value-added measures for specific student groups. There are two ways to view information in this report. Users can choose the View Growth by Subject Area or View Growth by Student Group tabs for a district or school. This report shows growth across tests and grades for a subject or student group. The report displays the growth measure, standard error, growth index, and effectiveness level where available. The information in this report helps users assess growth trends among different student groups and see whether meaningful differences in growth exist. This insight can inform school improvement plans and instructional supports for these students. The data used in this report reflects data prior to the 2019-20 school year.
