TVAAS: What's New in 2022

Teacher Composite Updates

A teacher must have a 2021-22 Value-Added report to receive a composite. If data was available, the 2021-22 composite as well as the combined 2020-21 and 2021-22 composite were calculated.

Grade 3 and 4 Reporting Updates

Grade 3 and 4 value-added measures were calculated for the 2021-22 school year. These measures were not previously available for the 2020-21 school year.

Grade 5 Science Teacher Changes to Projections

All projections for assessments assume the 2019 average schooling experience, except for grades 5–8 Science and grades 6–8 Social Studies, which use the 2022 cohort as the comparison.

Growth of Student Groups Changes

Multiple years on the Growth of Student Groups report are now available as drop-down options.

Composite Changes

Value-added measures for 2022 Science and Social Studies are included in composites for educator evaluations but are excluded in 2022 district and school accountability measures.

Redesign of District and School Diagnostic Reports

District and School Diagnostic reports were updated earlier this year with additional content, a fresh new look and a user-friendly design. The percentiles from the Third Grade Percentile report have been relocated to the District and School Diagnostic reports.
